

## **Endangered Pedestrians on Heath Road, Lyng**

Since publishing an article on this subject in the August and October issues of Hill & Vale, Lyng Parish Council received calls from residents who were forced to avoid large and sometimes fast moving vehicles on Heath Road.

The Parish Council would like to encourage residents to record incidents of vehicles travelling dangerously or mounting the pavement in Heath Road.

Problems can occur when two vehicles meet on the bend and do not have enough room to pass.

Various people have verbally reported this happening and it is now important that we log such incidents. The situation is very dangerous for pedestrians in particular and drivers too. We need to have evidence of this happening to enable the Parish Council and members of the public to report back to Highways and other authorities so measures can be taken to avoid a serious accident.
