

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C216 Lime Kiln Road From its junction with A1067 Main Road, heading south for 50m in the PARISH OF SPARHAM because of full width machine patching.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 13th March 2017 to 15th March 2017 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 3 day within the period.

Alternative route is via: A1067 Main Road, C212 Elsing Lane, C216 Lime Kiln Road (Bawdeswell CP,Sparham, CP,Bylaugh CP)


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
